

INTRODUCTION:

This Service Information bulletin announces a design change made to the retaining bolt used to secure the child anchors to the rear shelf plates on the models listed above. This change was made in support of parts communization with other similar mounting bolts. There is no change between the old and new bolt in terms of function or durability.



PRODUCTION CHANGE INFORMATION:

The new bolts were incorporated as a running change. No starting VIN information is available.

The part number for the new FLANGE BOLT is: 901000473.


