Work Procedure:

Information

Since the size and shape of the PORSCHE projector differs from the door warning light installed in the vehicle, the door panels **must** be removed.

- 1 Remove door panels
 - 1.1 Remove door panels on driver's and passenger's side. \Rightarrow Workshop Manual 'Removing and installing front door panel'
 - 1.2 Remove door warning light.
 - 1.3 Insert PORSCHE projector "at the bottom" so that the retaining lugs at the left and right \Rightarrow *Figure 3*-1- are engaged securely. Clip in projector at the top and make sure that the retaining lugs at the left and right \Rightarrow *Figure 3*-2- engage. Check that the projector is fitted securely.



 - 2.1 Read out and erase the fault memory. ⇒ Workshop Manual 'Fault memory for on-board diagnosis'
- Working Time: Installing 96162440 PORSCHE projector.

Includes: Removing and installing door panels on driver's and passenger's side, reading out and erasing fault memory

Labor time: 110 TU
