ShoreLand'r Trailer customers:

As a result of the anti-dumping and other tariffs that were recently put in place on steel trailer wheels made in China, our supplier, Carlstar has moved production of all steel trailer wheels to other countries including the USA. As a part of this transition, Carlstar is unable to continue to supply us with the directional style wheels that we have been using for many years.

During the next couple of months, we will be making a change from the directional style wheels to the supreme style. The supreme style has round holes vs. the directional holes (see attached image). This change will not happen on all sizes at the same time but will take place on all steel wheels from 12" through 15" starting very soon and continuing through July and August. The painted and galvanized finishes on the wheels will continue to be the same high quality that you are accustomed to receiving.

We expect this to be a semi-permanent change – we may elect to move back to the directional rims once tooling is in place but this is likely to be quite a ways out in the future.
