SUBJECT:

Transfer Case Oil Leak

OVERVIEW:

This bulletin involves removing and replacing six of the transfer case extension housing bolts.

MODELS:

2019 (JL) Jeep Wrangler

NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles within the following markets/countries: NAFTA,

EMEA, LATAM and APAC.

NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles built on or after January 26, 2019 (MDH 0126XX) and built on or before February 08, 2019 (MDH 0208XX) equipped with 4:1 Rock-Trac HD Part Time 4WD System (Sales Code DHW) or **4:1 Rock-Trac HD Full Time 4WD System (Sales Code DHF).**

SYMPTOM/CONDITION:

Customers may notice a fluid leaking on the ground from the middle of vehicle.

DIAGNOSIS:

If a customer's VIN is listed in VIP or your RRT VIN list, perform the repair. If any vehicle not on the VIN list exhibits the symptom/condition, perform the repair.

PARTS REQUIRED:

3	06510210AA	Trans Mount to Cross-Member Nuts
6	68456804AA	Retainer Housing Bolts

REPAIR PROCEDURE:

1. To gain access to the extension housing bolts remove the transmission cross member (Fig. 1) . Refer to the detailed service procedures available in DealerCONNECT> Service Library under: 13 - Frame and Bumpers / Frame / Cross member, Transmission / Removal.

NOTE: Discard the old trans mount to cross member nuts and isolator bolts, install new ones. do not reuse.

NOTE: Remove, replace and re-torque one extension housing bolt at a time (Fig. 2) no particular order is required, suggested order is clockwise. This will help prevent a fluid leak.

2. Remove and discard the old bolts, replace with new bolts and re-torque the six extension housing bolts, one at a time. Torque bolts to 26 N·m (19 ft. lbs.) (Fig. 2).



3. Install the transmission cross member. Refer to the detailed service procedures available in DealerCONNECT> Service Library under: 13 - Frame and Bumpers / Frame / Cross member, Transmission /Installation (Fig. 1).
