# SUBJECT:

UJQ with RS9 Radio Enhancements

# OVERVIEW:

This bulletin involves inspecting and if required, updating the radio software. level to 21.9.

# MODELS:

Jeep Renegade

# NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles within the following markets/countries: EMEA.

# NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles equipped with Uconnect 8.4 navigation radio (Sales Codes UJQ) without Digital Audio Broadcasting (Sales Code RS9).

# SYMPTOM/CONDITION:

Customers may experience one or more of the following:

- If the vehicle has been turned off for a long time, the settings for auto folding side mirrors is turned off
- Radio resets intermittently.
- Radio display screen locks up.
- Park assist chime will continue to chime, after the vehicle is turned off.
- Radio will display the incorrect speed limit in kph, when approaching a road speed camera.
- Uconnect Live feature may not function properly.

#### **DIAGNOSIS:**

Using a Scan Tool (wiTECH) with the appropriate Diagnostic Procedures available in DealerCONNECT/Service Library, verify all related systems are functioning as designed. If Diagnostic Trouble Codes (DTCs) or symptom conditions, other than the ones listed above are present, record the issues on the repair order and repair as necessary before proceeding further with this bulletin.

If the customer describes any of the symptom/condition listed above, perform the Inspection Procedure.

# **INSPECTION:**

- 1. Verify the radio software version. Radio must be in Dealer Mode to verify. To put the radio in Dealer Mode, follow these steps:
  - a. Press and hold both lower corners of the display screen, until the Dealer Mode screen appears (approximately seven seconds). Release buttons.
  - b. Select "Radio Part Information". The software level will be listed next to "Application Version".
- 2. Is the radio currently at software level 21.9 or higher (Fig. 1) ?
  - YES >>> The radio software is already up to date. Normal diagnostic should be performed.
  - NO >>> The radio software needs to be updated. Back out of Dealer Mode and proceed to Step 1 of the Repair Procedure.

# **REPAIR PROCEDURE:**


- NOTE: A 16 GB USB flash drive is required for this update. The normal 4 GB USB flash drive will not be sufficient.
- 1. Has a 16 GB USB flash drive been created?
  - YES >>> Proceed to Step 11.
  - NO >>> Proceed to Step 2.
- NOTE: When downloading the navigation software file equipped with an Uconnect 8.4 navigation radio, always select the MAC version, regardless of the computer being used.
- 2. Go to DealerCONNECT>Service>Uconnect Command Center>Uconnect>More Information >Dealer software downloads to download the files.
- 3. If a security message appears "Do you want to view only the web page content that was delivered securely?" (Fig. 2) . Press "No" to continue.

- NOTE: If the software cannot be downloaded, make sure you have proper security access. If not, have the Service Manager or Shop Foreman download the software update.
- 4. Use a blank USB flash drive with at least 16GB of space. Follow the on-screen instructions to download the software files.

5. Download the software update file to your local PC's desktop. Make sure to select the "MAC" radial button for all downloads (Fig. 3).



MAC Download Steps

- 6. Be sure to download the file to your designated folder before extracting the zip file to the blank USB flash drive.
- 7. A blank USB flash drive will be needed for each radio update, additional updates can not be on the same USB flash drive.

8. Extract the downloaded zip file to the designated USB flash drive (Fig. 4) and (Fig. 5) .

NOTE: It may take a few minutes for an accurate extract time to be displayed.

- CAUTION! The engine must be running and radio powered on during the update. Failure to do so may result in the radio not being updated and create connectivity issues.
- NOTE: DO NOT remove the USB flash drive during the update.

9. Verify the content on the flash drive matches (Fig. 6) for Navigation equipped radios and (Fig. 7) for Non-Navigation equipped radios.

- 10. Once the file is extracted to the USB flash drive, it is recommended to label the USB flash drive with the bulletin number and proper radio Sales Codes.
- 11. Start the vehicle and insert the correct USB flash drive, with new software, into the USB port.

- CAUTION! Make sure no other device is plugged into any of the USB ports while performing this re-program. If other devices are connected to USB ports during re-programming, it may cause failure of files to be loaded which may cause the radio to need replacement.
- 12. If the screen in (Fig. 8) is displayed, the USB flash drive was not set up correctly. Use a top name brand USB and create a new flash drive, then start the update again.

NOTE: If the ignition is turned off before the two minute has expired, the software update will be canceled. The ignition does not have to be turned off to perform this updated. (Fig. 10).




Fig. 9 Software Update Is Available

13. Once the system has verified there is an available update, press the "Update Now" button. Make sure the vehicle is in park, **DO NOT turn off the ignition** (Fig. 9) .

14. If the ignition is turned off before the two minute has expired, the software update will be canceled (Fig. 10).

15. The radio will reboot and the update will begin (Fig. 11).

- NOTE: Some display screens will not be displayed, if the ignition is turned off during the update.
- 16. After the update has completed, the radio will shut down. With the USB flash drive still inserted in the USB port, turn the ignition back to the run position. If the radio has been updated correctly, the screen in (Fig. 12) will be displayed. Press "OK" and remove the USB flash drive.

17. Press the Nav icon at the bottom of the touchscreen. Verify that the Navigation menu comes up on the screen.

- Using the wiTECH, clear all DTCs that may have been set in any module due to reprogramming. The wiTECH application will automatically present all DTCs after the flash and allow them to be cleared.
- NOTE: After performing the radio update, the radio display screen may have a ghost image that will not clear even after turning off the ignition. This ghost image may appear on any radio screens selected. Do not replace the radio for this concern, turn the vehicle off and allow the radio and vehicle to enter a full power down cycle. A full power down cycle may take between 45 to 60 minutes.

- NOTE: The "One Time Only" LOP is used one time per dealer when downloading the software onto a USB flash drive. The dealer can only use the download LOP, one time for each of the radios listed.
- NOTE: The expected completion time for the flash download portion of this procedure is approximately 30 minutes. Actual flash download times may be affected by vehicle connection and network capabilities.

# FAILURE CODE:

The dealer must use failure code CC with this Service Bulletin.

- If the customer's concern matches the SYMPTOM/CONDITION identified in the Service Bulletin, failure code CC is to be used.
- When utilizing this failure code, the 3C's (customer's concern, cause and correction) must be provided for processing Service Bulletin flash/reprogramming conditions.
