Technical Background

Clogged sunroof drains may cause water leaks in the A-pillar areas. This may result in water ingress into TIUL coupling connector which may result in various system faults.

Faults that may be present are C101C4A, C101C29, C101D29, C101D4A, C101D29, C101C14, C101D14, C114602, B10B300.

Service

1. Check vehicle history for any prior water leak repairs, especially those were originated from the sunroof assembly
2. Access the TIUL coupling connections in the lower driver A-pillar area and inspect for water damage and/or corrosion. See figure-1.
3. If corrosion is found, diagnose and repair the cause of the water leak. Then clean and/or re-pin connectors as needed.

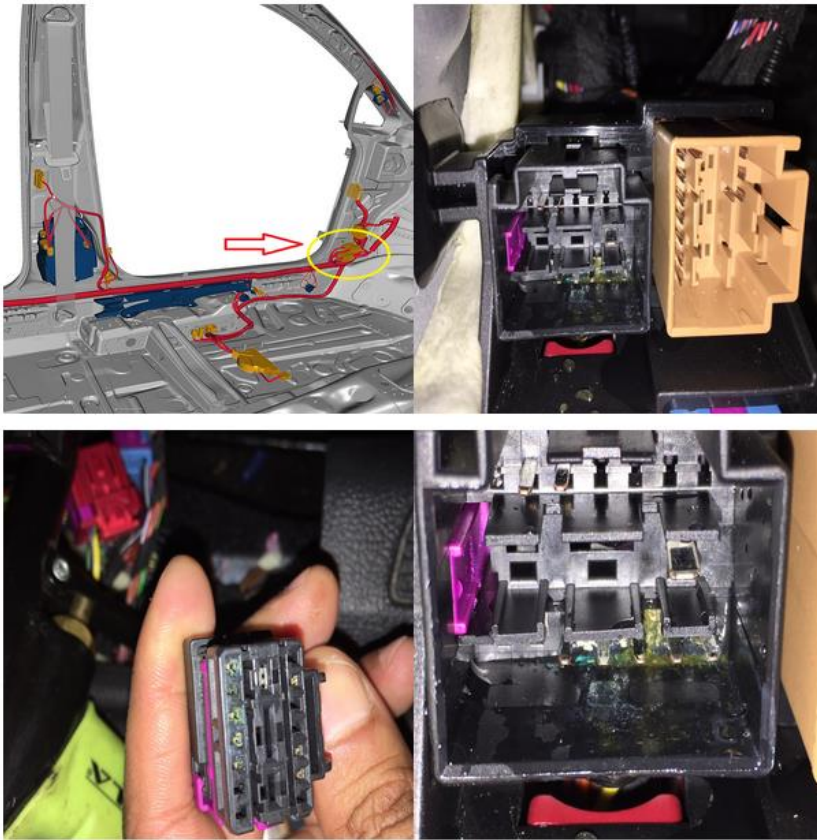
