Tailgate latch is squeaking

SITUATION

The tailgate latch is squeaking when opening or closing the tailgate.

CAUSE


The latch has become contaminated with dirt.

CORRECTION

Clean the latch with a dry cloth or compressed air if necessary, and lubricate the rotary striker.

<u>PROCEDURE</u>

For conditions that are similar to the situation described:



1. Remove the contamination from the tailgate lock with a dry cloth and if necessary, compressed air.

Note: Do not remove the tailgate latch from the vehicle. It is shown removed for clarity.

- 2. Clean the striker with a dry cloth.
- 3. Grease the rotary striker on the latch with BMW Sunroof Lubricant (p/n 83 19 2 157 321) in the areas shown.



NOTE: Use screwdriver to close latch to avoid a pinch hazard.

- Grease in the open and closed positions, but do not apply excessively.
- 4. Open and close the tailgate three times to spread the grease across the mechanism.

Verify that the squeaking has been eliminated.
