Model 579 Battery Box Road Debris Closeout

Introduction

Peterbilt has determined that certain model 579 trucks, built from 11/03/2014 to 7/29/2019 and equipped with chassis fairings, were built with battery boxes that have openings near the step support. These openings can allow road debris to enter the box.

Resolution

FIX-AS-FAIL

If a customer comes into your dealership and demonstrates the condition above, add the closeout that has been designed to cover these openings.

Warranty

Through Standard Warranty, Peterbilt will pay for parts at dealer net plus applicable mark-up and labor:

- 0.3 hours labor to install the battery box closeout. Use quick claim number 02150.
- Ensure all required parts have arrived prior to scheduling the chassis for the repair.
- Direct Fleets and Dealer Sponsored Fleets (DSF) may not use quick claims when submitting for repairs on chassis related to this bulletin but must submit a long form specifying part numbers, quantities, and pricing for parts used in the repair. Submittal of a Quick Claim for repairs made by the Fleet will be denied as pricing is incorrect on quick claims.
- File an additional claim for extraordinary circumstances, referencing 02150 in the CCC. A quick claim for standard labor must be filed first.

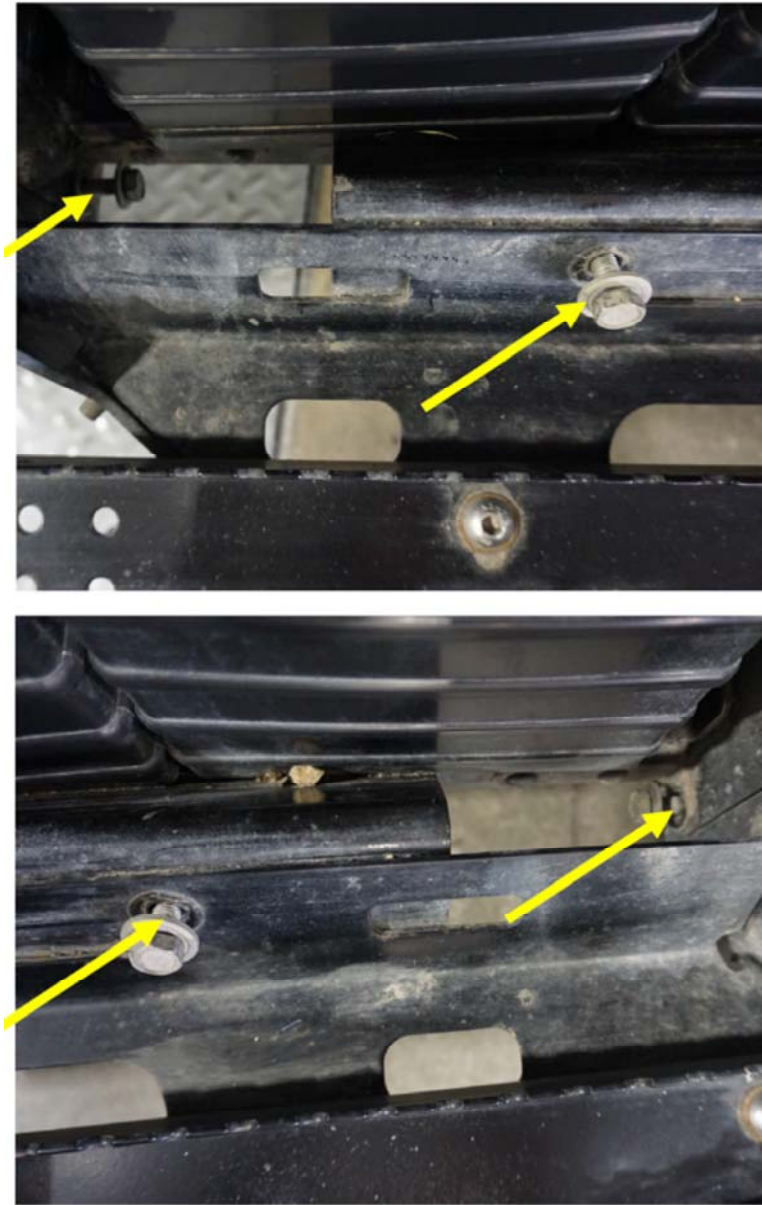

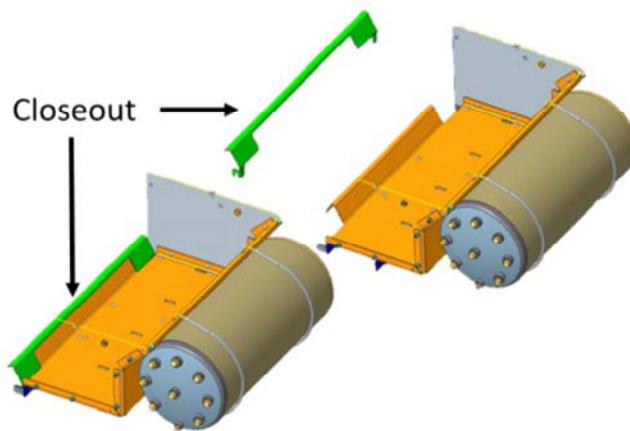

4. Reinstall battery box cover.
