Battery Testing Process. *								
Note: The VAS 6161 and GRX3000VAS are the only approved VW tools that can be used to test and charge batteries in VW vehicles.								
Check exterior and interior surfaces—make sure they are clean and free of environmental damage, scratches, dents, dings, etc. If any defects are found, contact the Service Manager to schedule immediate repair.								
Check tires for proper inflation pressure. **								
Drive vehicle a minimum of 1 mile (1.6 kilometers). At 20 mph (32 km/h) gradually apply brakes several times. This will eliminate brake rotor deposits and prevent flat spotting of the tires.								
Remove the existing 30-Day Inventory Maintenance sticker from the windshield. Affix next sticker (P/N INVSTKR) to the inside, upper left corner of windshield. Record the date of the <u>next</u> 30-day service.

Select correct din rating from battery label.

**Select correct battery type
Regular Lead Acid or AGM or EFB.**

**	For vehicles for display, set tire pressures to customer (normal) operational settings. For vehicles in off-site storage, set tire pressures to transportation settings.
