Customer states:

- The Adaptive Cruise Assist feature, along with other driver assistance systems is not working.

Workshop findings:

The following DTC may be stored in the control module for adaptive cruise control, J428 (address word 0013):

- DTC C110300** (Adaptive cruise control sensor misadjusted) with symptom code 791.

Technical Background

Various parts have been replaced or recalibrated under warranty for the condition noted above, but no issues were identified with these parts. In an effort to gain information on the DTC codes for the vehicles listed above, we are asking that you contact the Audi Technical Assistance Center (TAC) before replacing or recalibrating any parts. This will assist us in diagnosing any potential issues with the condition noted above.
