Condition	Some customers may comment the headrest monitors shut off intermittently. With the fob inside or outside the vehicle, occurring with the closing of all doors/ hatch				
Cause	A momentary loss of power to the monitors on vehicles with keyless ignition due to the iRAP feed being disabled for fob detection.				

Correction:

GM engineering is currently evaluating this concern. Please do not replace any parts or make any repairs. This Pl will be updated or a bulletin will be created when further repair information is available.

- On some vehicles with push button start (keyless ignition), if you turn on the headrest monitor, and then close all doors/ hatch while standing outside the vehicle with the remote keyless entry/ignition FOB in your possession, the monitor will shut off. To avoid this issue, leave a door ajar until the driver takes the FOB back inside the vehicle.
- This condition is normal operation and is described in the Rear Seat Infotainment owner's manual, page 5.
- On some vehicles with push button start (keyless ignition) AND a wireless charging system, if you turn on the headrest monitor, and remain in the vehicle with the remote keyless entry/ignition FOB in your

possession, the monitor will shut off if it is close to the wireless charger upon closing of all doors/ hatch. To avoid this issue, keep the FOB away from the wireless charging system.
