SITUATION

Touchless vehicle unlocking and locking cannot be switched on from the iDrive; or this feature is not present in the CID.

CAUSE

Software error in the Body Domain Controller (BDC) control unit.

CORRECTION

Reprogram the vehicle.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Perform diagnosis with the latest version of ISTA, working through the test module, if needed.
- 2. Program the vehicle using ISTA 4.18.32 or higher (released August 2019).

Note that ISTA will automatically reprogram and code all programmable control modules that do not have the latest software.

Always connect a BMW-approved battery charger/power supply (SI B04 23 10).

- B. For control module failures that occurred prior to performing this programming procedure;
 - When covered under an applicable limited warranty, claim this control module-related repair work using the applicable defect code and labor operations (including diagnosis) in AIR.
