Interim Repair Procedure

- 1. Verify customer concern.
- 2. Disconnect and reconnect the vehicle battery at the 1:00 hour. Note:
 - If the customer cannot wait for the 1:00 hour to perform this procedure, put the customer in a loaner vehicle.
 - This procedure must be repeated every time the battery is disconnected.
- 3. Verfy repair.
