<u>Customer Voice:</u> • The vehicle felt like it would stall when slowing down. • The vehicle stalled at a stop and I could restart it. <u>Technical Description:</u> • The condition has been logged when approaching a stop. • No relevant PCM DTCs are stored, rectification of DTCs stored in other control modules have not resolved the stalling complaint. • The vehicle can be restarted on the next ignition cycle. <u>Status:</u> • This topic is under investigation. • Road test the vehicle from cold through operating temperature while performing multiple stops during this time.
