Steering Wheel Off Center

OVERVIEW:

This bulletin involves centering the steering wheel.

MODELS:

2019 (WD)

Dodge Durango

NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles within the following markets/countries: North

America and EMEA.

NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles built on or after March 31, 2019 (MDH 0331XX) and on or before July 22, 2019 (MDH 0722XX).

SYMPTOM/CONDITION:

The customer may describe:

• The steering wheel is off center.

DIAGNOSIS:

If a customer's VIN is listed in VIP or your RRT VIN list, perform the repair. **This RRT only applies** to vehicles on the RRT VIN list.

- 1. Test drive the vehicle "as is" before making any changes to confirm the steering wheel is off center. Refer to DealerCONNECT> Service Library for the published Service Bulletin specific to diagnosing a "Steering Wheel Not Centered" condition.
- 2. Was the steering wheel found to be off center?
 - YES>>> Continue with Step 1 of the Repair Procedure.
 - NO>>> This Bulletin has been completed. Use inspect LOP (**02-00-99-92**) to close the
 active RRT.

REPAIR PROCEDURE:

1. Check and adjust toe as necessary. Refer to the detailed service procedure for setting "Toe" available in DealerCONNECT> Service Library under: Service Info 02 Front Suspension> Wheel Alignment> Standard Procedure> Wheel Alignment> Toe Adjustment.

POLICY:

Reimbursable within the provisions of the warranty.
