When selecting to update the date (Figure 1) and time (Figure 2) by GPS, the two features will no longer automatically update via GPS

NOTE: Referring to Figure 1, when the Use GPS date button is pressed the date reverts back to an earlier date (The example shown in this case is 16 FEB 2000)
