| Condition                  | Some customers may come in with a whistle, squeal, or squeak noise from the engine area. This noise may get more noticeable after driving for a while.   |
| Cause                      | The cause of this noise may be plastic flashing restricting the clean air port on the air cleaner duct on top of the engine as shown below.  The restriction or flashing will appear that the hole is not drilled out completely and can be seen about 2 inches inside the tube. |





#### Correction:

To correct this condition, replace the air cleaner duct and reevaluate for a noise concern.

Make sure you run the engine long enough to build up crankcase pressure during testing to ensure correction.
