### **Correction:**

Inspect and adjust the rear seat using the information below.

#### Service Procedure;

Inspect the alignment of the bumpers in the latch in relation to the striker. (Illustration 1 below.)




Illustration #2 below shows both bumpers engaged .




Illustration #3 shows the latch aligned too far right , only one bumper engaged.





Illustration #4 shows latch aligned too far left , only one bumper engaged.



To align the striker to the insulators , loosen the nuts on the studs left and right shown below and move the seat left or right until centered.



#### Once aligned retorque the nuts on the studs to 45 Nm (33 lbs ft) and verify repair.
