Resetting the Service Interval Display

If service was not performed by a Volkswagen dealer, the display must be reset as follows:

- Use the rocker switch on the windshield wiper lever or the buttons in the multi-function steering wheel (where applicable) to select the **Settings** menu.
- In the **Service** submenu mark the **Reset** menu item and press the OK button in the windshield wiper lever or the multi-function steering wheel (where applicable) to reset the Service Interval Display. Confirm the subsequent security check with OK.



Tips

- If you reset the service display yourself, the next service is displayed after 9,320 miles (15,000 km) or one year. The service interval is not determined individually.
- Do **not** reset the service interval function between scheduled maintenance intervals; doing so will result in an incorrect display.
