Technical Background

If the 12 volt outlet remains ON after the key is cycled OFF, this can be accomplished on these vehicles depending upon fuse installation. The SC40 fuse has dual slots to allow for battery power (30 power) and ignition power (15 power).

Service

Check the SC40 fuse location and install for battery or ignition power desired.
