SUBJECT: DD5 and DD8 Engines with Fault Code 723/8

ISSUE

DD5 and DD8 engines with a complaint of fault code **SPN 723/ FMI 8** and **built <u>before</u> February 2019** may have camshaft position (CMP) sensor terminal fretting due to vibration.

REQUIRED ACTION

If diagnostics confirms CMP terminal fretting (which may not be visible), the engine will require camshaft position sensor and injector harness replacement <u>as a pair.</u> <u>Do NOT replace the engine sensor harness.</u>

REPAIR PROCEDURE

Refer to DTNAConnect (TechLit) for repair procedures and replace the following parts:

- Camshaft position sensor
- NEW injector harness using part numbers:

DD5: DDE A 934 150 01 37DD8: DDE A 936 150 04 37

All old stock of previous injector harnesses have been scrapped and are not available for ordering.
