WJ07 Workshop campaign - Checking plastic rear window and replacing it if necessary

Overview

There is a possibility that the plastic rear window can become partially detached from the body at the bonding area on the affected vehicles due to chemical incompatibility and impurities during the manufacturing process for the plastic rear window.

This can result in noises and can subsequently cause the rear window to start leaking and water can leak into the vehicle interior over the service life of the vehicle.

To prevent this from happening, the rear window on the affected vehicles must be checked and replaced if necessary.

*** If necessary, the adhesive set can be ordered using the specified Porsche part number or from your expendable items supplier.

If the adhesive set is purchased from the local supplier, enter the **Part No. WJ070000002**, "adhesive" designation as an additional part costing \$141.25 during warranty processing.
