- Microphone remains on screen after voice recognition failure
- Unable to see text with headlights on (text is same color as background)

- Phone does not auto-connect on startup •
- Intermittent black screen

- Abnormal phone book sorting
- Unable to see DCM Status when in dark red or dark blue modes
- XM no signal banner appears at all times

- USB audio does not resume

- Navigation Inoperative
- Microphone disconnected pop-up message
- Clock not displayed on the map screen
