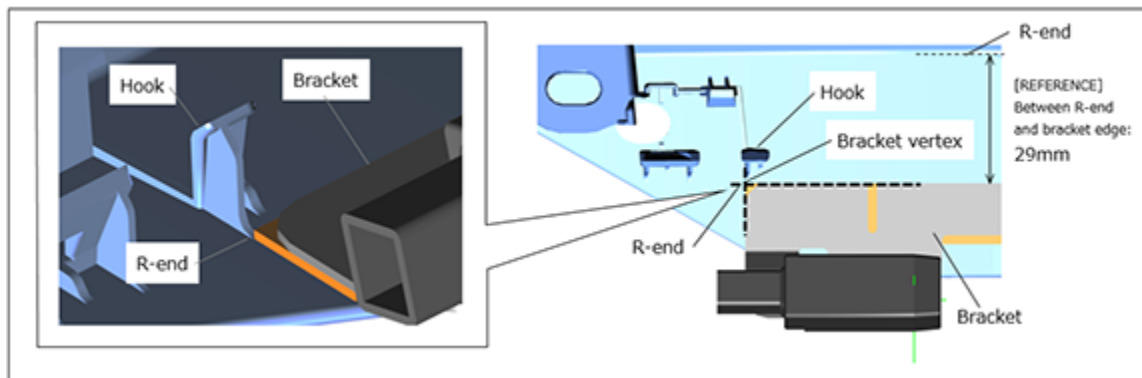

DESCRIPTION

Due to a manufacturing change on the 2020 CX-5, there is an update in the installation instructions that will be reflected in the next printing. The new instructions will have a suffix "A" Part Number. If the instructions do not have a suffix "A", install the ILK per the instructions until page 32, step 3, and then following the instructions below.

Instructions

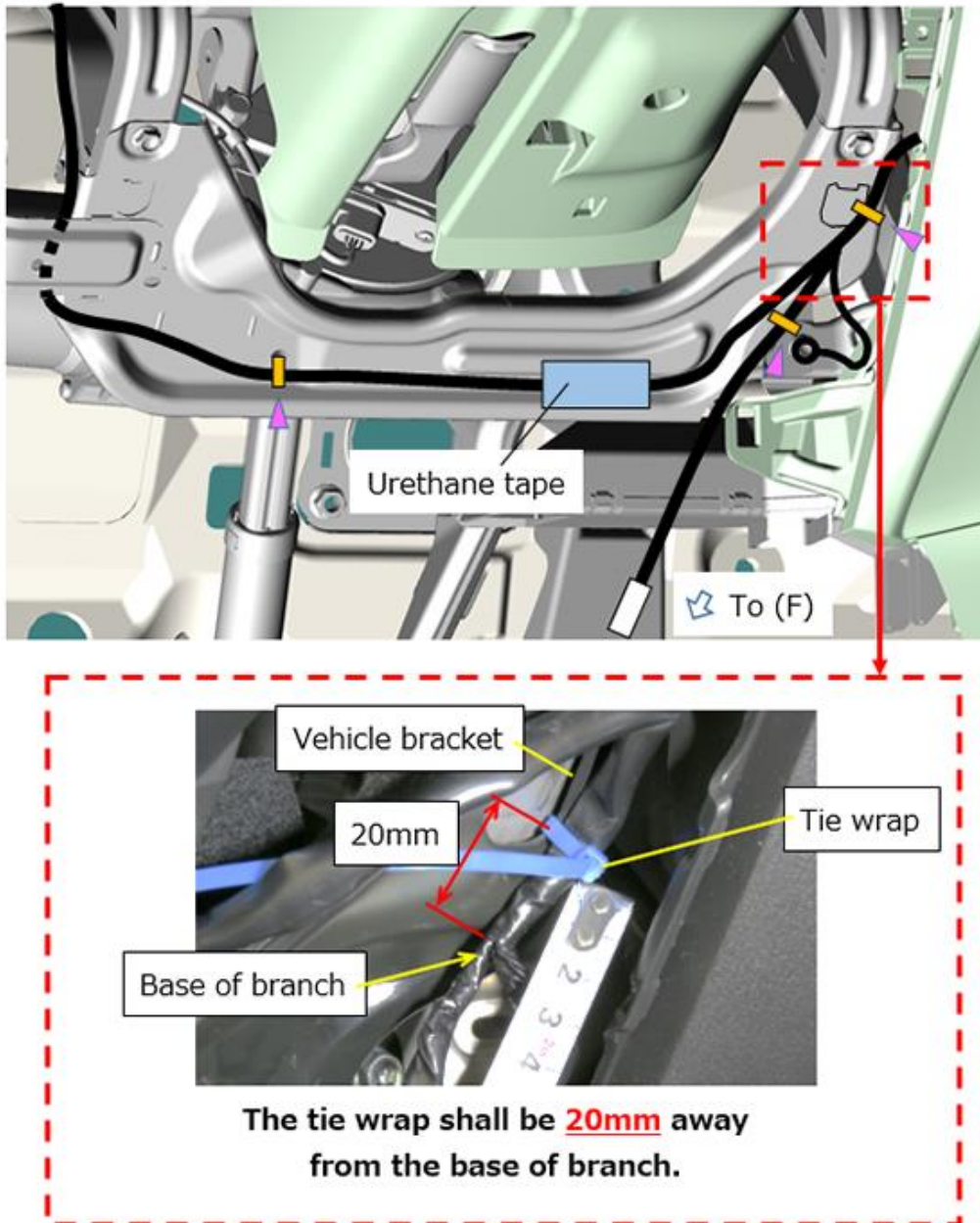
1. Page 32, step 3: Peel off the paper backings of double-sided adhesive tape A, then align the LED bracket to R-end of the hook in the driver's side lower panel and adhere the LED lamp as shown.



2. Proceed with installation following the original installation instructions (pg.33-35)

3. Page 36, Installation (D) step 2: Secure the main harness to the vehicle wiring harness using tie wraps as shown.



4. Proceed with the remainder of the installation following the original installation instructions.
