

WKK7 Workshop campaign – Re-coding airbag control unit

Important Notes:

This campaign is the **successor campaign to WKG8** and includes all necessary work.

To this end, pay particular **attention** to the following during campaign implementation:

- The scope of work **described here** must be **performed** on all the vehicles assigned to the campaign, even if the WKG8 campaign was already performed on the vehicle. Invoice the campaign as usual.
 - For vehicles on which an open PQIS line for campaign WKG8 exists and the campaign has **not** yet been carried out, the task line must be closed and the campaign claim must be invoiced with **0 TU and without material (recall update)**.
 - For vehicles on which an open PQIS line for campaign WKG8 exists and the campaign was **carried out**, the process must be **completed** using the relevant warranty claim.

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Overview

The airbag control unit on the affected vehicles was coded with an incorrect data record.

As a result, the Event Data Recorder (EDR) function is activated although this is not yet approved for the vehicle type. This function can be used to record certain historical data without the customer's consent in the event of an accident.

To deactivate this function again, the airbag control unit must be re-coded using an updated data record.
