Lock Sets, Key Codes, and Bitting Numbers:

With the launch of International's new product series, there have been some changes to the cab door locks and key codes. The main change has been going from the Z-code (DuraStar, WorkStar, PayStar, ProStar, and pre-2018 LoneStar) to the new I-code (MV, HV, HX, RH, LT, and 2018 LoneStar). When these codes were changed they were not meant to be 1 to 1 carry over from a Z-code to an I-code. (i.e... Z250 and I0250 are not interchangeable or backwards compatible) Additional key codes have been released to make enough I-codes interchangeable & backwards compatible to Z-codes: Z001-Z262. Important Notice:

- MV and DuraStar Cab Door lockset parts are not interchangeable.
- HV and WorkStar Cab Door lockset parts are not interchangeable.
- HX and PayStar Cab Door lockset parts are not interchangeable.
- RH/LT and ProStar/TransStar Cab Door lockset parts are not interchangeable.

How to find the bitting number for cutting keys:

Note: The bitting number is a unique code per VIN needed for the key cutting machine to cut the specific key for the VIN you are working with.

Use Parts Catalog to retrieve the ignition key code listed in Ignition Key field or Enter the VIN in the Service Portal and go to the serial numbers tab to find the same ignition key code. (Z-code or I-code). Special Note Concerning the cross reference between some I-codes & Z-codes:

The cross-over codes are mainly for customers who still have an older Star series truck and purchase a new series truck and want the same key to work on both the old and the new trucks. The lockset hardware is still different between the old and the new, but the key blanks (2506694C1) are the same and can work in either lock set. In most cases, the lock set in the newer truck would have to be changed.

How to cut a key for a truck with either an I-code or a Z-code:

- Determine key bitting information using process defined above.
- Cut blank key **2506694C1** with bitting information using a key cutting machine that is programed with International Bitting codes.

How to replace locksets on new series truck with an I-code to match a corresponding "Star" series truck with a Z-code:

- Determine key code cross reference (Use Z-code to determine corresponding I-Code or vise-versa) using process defined above.
- Order a new lock set with the corresponding I-code/Z-code as found on lock set list below or order a direct ship lock set for keyed alike or for key codes not stocked in PDC.

How to order keyed alike locksets and pre-cut keys from direct ship:

- Choose Direct Ship part numbers on the attachment.
- Place your order via Parts Online

- Provide Quantity, Part Number and Key Code. It is very important to provide all this information as a note on the order.
