

Field Service Campaign D19M-5 for MY2018 and MY2019 DETROIT™ DD5 Reprogramming is now published on DTNAConnect. The updated software includes several improvements for throttle response and acceleration at vehicle start. Additionally, updated fuel maps also increase the torque rating on the 200 hp / 560 ft-lbs and 220 hp / 560 ft-lbs engines as described in the table below. Due to highly regulated guidelines, the factory changeover for these improved fuel maps will be completed through a “running change” to MY2020 engines in late Q1 2020. A separate field service campaign will be initiated to reprogram the MY2020 population delivered prior to the factory change.



- Improved throttle response and acceleration at cold start with DD5 engines
- Increase torque rating on 200 hp / 560 ft-lbs and 220 hp / 560 ft-lbs engines
