Subject: Stop Delivery Order for Potential Emission Recall

Models: 2020 Chevrolet Camaro  
Equipped with 3.6L 6-cylinder Gas Engine (RPO LGX)

To: All General Motors Dealers

**STOP DELIVERY ORDER**

Effective immediately, stop the delivery of certain 2020 model year Chevrolet Camaro vehicles in new or used vehicle inventory. General Motors is currently investigating a potential emission issue. The GM reference number is N192284430.

It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification until the potential emissions issue is remedied.

We currently are investigating a concern with bleed loss emissions from the evaporative emissions canister exceeding emissions standard specified for the Bleed Emissions Test Procedure (BETP).

Once the investigation is complete, GM will release a bulletin publishing the repair if a remedy is needed.

Until further instructions are received, involved vehicles that are in dealers' possession (new or used vehicle inventory, GM Certified Used, courtesy transportation vehicles, dealer shuttle vehicles, etc.) must be held and not delivered to customers, dealer-traded, released to auction, used for demonstration purposes or any other dealer use. All GM Certified Used vehicles currently in the dealers' inventory within the Certified Pre-Owned Inventory System (CPOIS) will be de-certified.

The Investigate Vehicle History (IVH) screen in the Global Warranty Management (GWM) system will be updated as "Stop Delivery – Awaiting Communication" for this potential recall on October 31, 2019. This action has been taken to assist dealers with determining which vehicles are involved so they can properly respond to customer inquiries.

A list of involved vehicles that have been identified as being in dealer new vehicle inventory is attached to this message. It is sorted by dealer Business Associate Code (BAC) for easy reference. Your dealership's BAC will not be listed if none of the involved vehicles are currently in your new vehicle inventory. A file identifying involved vehicles in dealer used inventory will be published in GM GlobalConnect, under the Service tab in Field Action Inventory Reports.
