Technical Background

The replacement test plan for address word 5F is not loading the SWaP keys that activate certain functions of the infotainment system like App-Connect, Bluetooth and Navigation for example.

Service

After replacement of a MIB2 radio, and running the replacement test plan:

• Click on the Special Functions tab and run the "Ctrl. module software configuration" for address word 5F.

Once the test plan finishes.

• Select the FES "Function clearing system (FES)", selecting #2 "Re-create function" for address word 5F.

Allow the test plan to finish and retest operation.
