Service Procedure:

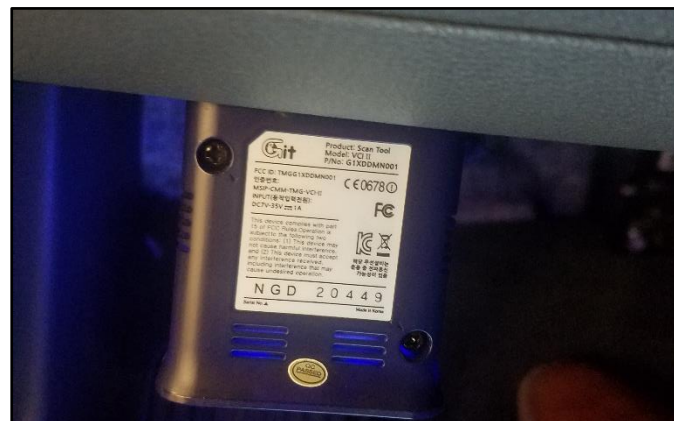
1. Press **Engine Start Stop** button.



2. Insert the GDS scan tool into the vehicle's **Onboard Diagnostic II (OBD II)** port.

NOTICE

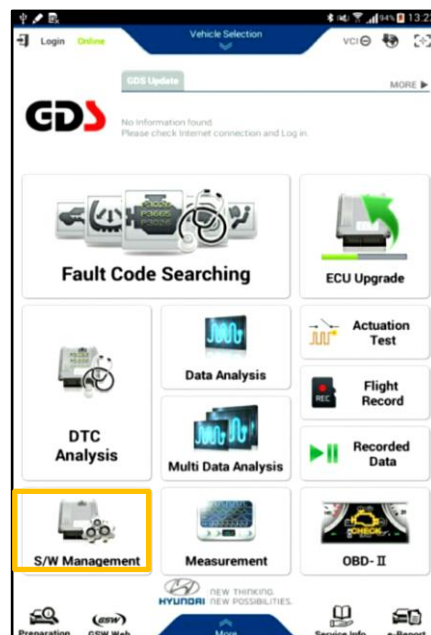
The GDS scan tool must sit flush inside the OBD II port and the **Function light** must appear before proceeding further.



3. Turn on the GDS tablet and select **S/W Management**.

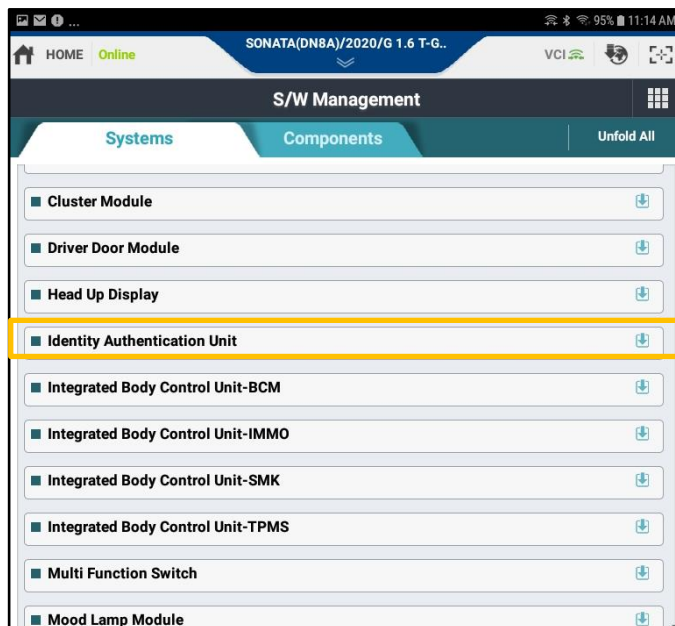
NOTICE

An **Error Message** will appear on GDS screen if the scan tool is not properly inserted in the OBD II port after selecting S/W Management



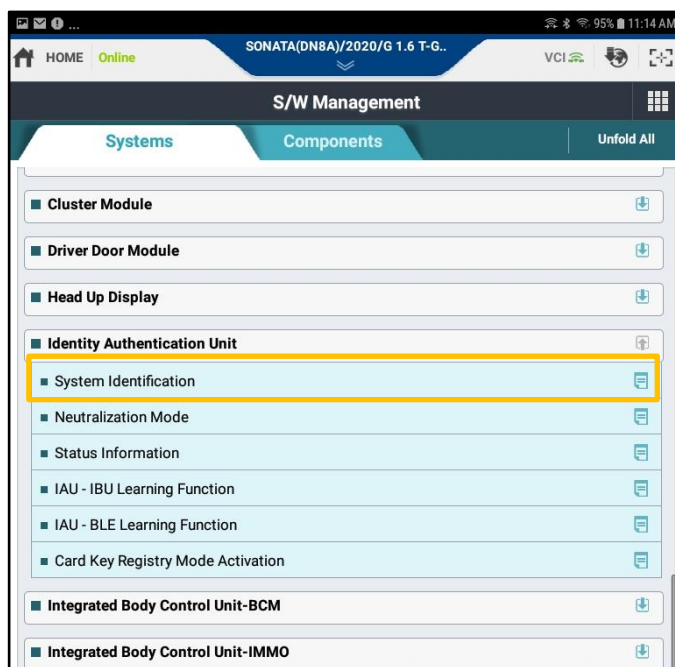
4. After selecting S/W Management, a vehicle components list will appear on the GDS screen.

Select the **Identity Authentication Unit**.



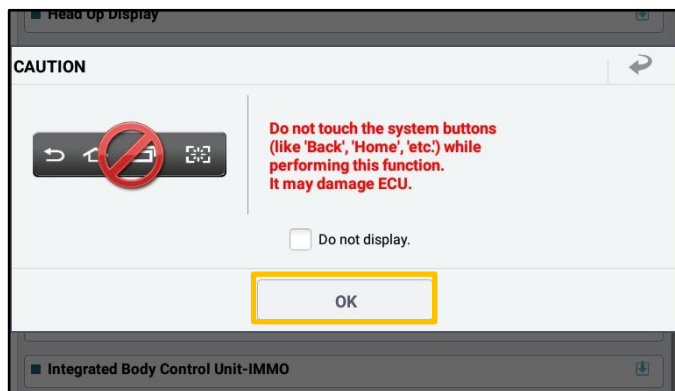
5. After selecting Identity Authentication Unit, a drop down list will appear.

Select **System Identification**.



6. **Caution. Do not touch the system buttons (like 'Back', 'Home', 'etc.') while performing this function. It may damage ECU** pop-up message may appear.

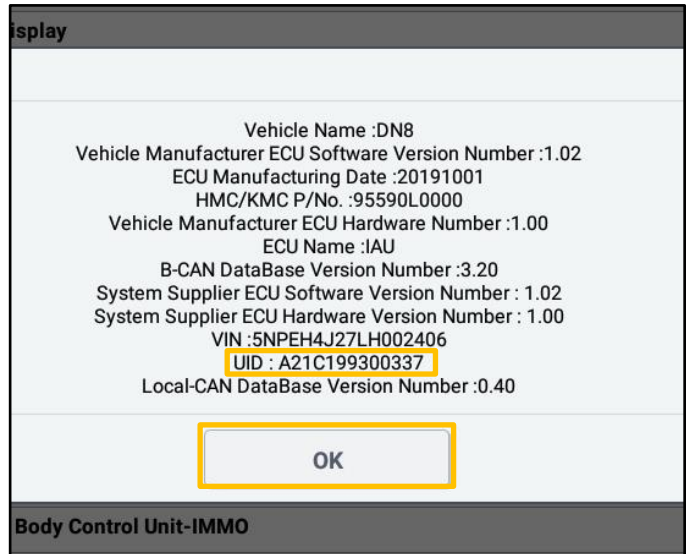
Select **OK**.
