The average score will never change and driver assistance popups will not display. A future software update will resolve the issue.

The affected CECU software version is P30-1041-111.

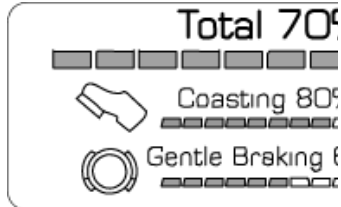
