#### **Service Procedure**

- 1. Lift the vehicle. Refer to Lifting and Jacking the Vehicle in SI.
- 2. Remove and reinstall each wheel individually, and then torque to 140 lb-ft (190N-m).
- 3. Lower the vehicle.
