
DRIVER ATTENTION WARNING (DAW) FEATURE

This Pitstop provides information on how to enable the Driver Attention Warning (DAW) feature on equipped Sedona (YP) vehicles. The default setting of this feature is set 'OFF' from the factory and needs to be enabled for operation utilizing the Kia Diagnostic System (KDS). This feature cannot be enabled via the user settings menu in the instrument cluster until it is first enabled by KDS.

Once this feature has been enabled, navigate to "Driver Assistance" under the User Settings menu in the instrument cluster and select "Driver Attention Warning". There will be 2 different sensitivity settings that can be selected, and an option to turn the system OFF.

To enable the DAW feature, follow the outline below:


1. On the main menu, select **S/W Management**.




2. Scroll to **Multi Function Camera** and select **Variant Coding**.




3. Select **OK**.




4. Select **ATTENTION ASSIST** option: **NONE**.




5. Select **ATTENTION ASSIST**. Select **OK**.



6. The completed Information screen will pop-up. Select **OK**.



7. Using the steering wheel controller, press the **MENU** key and use the **OK** button to scroll, for steps 8-10.



8. Scroll to **Driver Assistance** and press the 'OK' button.



9. Scroll to **Driver Attention Warning** and press 'OK' button.



10. Select the desired Driver Attention Warning sensitivity level (Off, Normal or High), press 'OK' button to set. (Example below was set to Normal Sensitivity)



11. Scroll to **Back**, and press the **OK** button to exit. Press the **MENU** key to exit the main menu. The DAW setting is now complete.
