### **Parts Information**

Tire information labels to be provided to ports free of charge.

NOTE: The option that contains the drive in/drive out allowance may only be claimed when the vehicle has been brought back into the workshop for this action alone to be undertaken.

## **Service Instruction**

NOTE: Some variation in the illustration may occur, but the essential information is always correct.

1. Open the front left door.

2. NOTE: The new adhesive tire information label must be installed in the same position as the previous adhesive tire information label.

Remove and discard the adhesive tire information label from the lower B-pillar panel.

- Clean the surrounding area.
- Remove the backing from the new adhesive tire information label.
- Install the new adhesive tire information label to the lower B-pillar panel.
