After performing work on the chain drive (chain/tensioner replacement), the adaptation value in the engine control module must be adapted.

Service

Switch ON the ignition and select the following menu items on the Vehicle Diagnostic Tester: 01 - Engine electronics > Guided Functions > Adaptation after repair work on the chain drive.

With updates to ODIS, the test plan is now located under Basic Settings > Chain Elongation Reset after Chain Replacement.
