## Condition

#### **Customer states:**

• The back lighting of the door switches flicker when the potentiometer is set to the maximum brightness level on the headlight switch.

#### Workshop findings:

• No DTC's are stored for this concern.

## **Technical Background**

Optimized software is now available to maintain the backlighting of the switch.

### **Production Solution**

New software in the door control modules, J386, J387, J388, and J389 (address word 0042, 0052, 00BB, and 00BC) addressed the condition.

### Service

#### Prerequisite work:

Completely open and close all windows using the main window switch. This ensures that all door control modules are awake for the update.

#### **SVM Update Instructions**

- 1. Follow all instructions in TSB 2011732: 00 Software Version Management (SVM), operating instructions.
- 2. Update the door control modules, J386, J387, J388, and J389 (address word 0042, 0052, 00BB, and 00BC) using the SVM action code as listed in the table below, if necessary:
