#### **Customer states:**

A rattling noise can be heard from the lower MMI (HVAC) display while driving.

### **Technical Background**

The noise is caused by a reduced gap between the center console and dashboard.

### **Production Solution**

Apply felt tape on the trim under the dashboard.



### **Service**

 Remove the center console trim.




Figure 1. Center console trim.

 If the plastic piece is not in direct contact with the trim (Figure 1), apply felt tape as shown.




Figure 3. Dashboard trim felt location.

2. Remove the dash trim and apply felt around the corners (Figure 2, 3 and 4).

**Tip:** Figure 1 depicts the center console insert (ETKA Illustration 863-052 Position 1). Figure 2, 3 and 4 all show the same lower dashboard trim (ETKA Illustration 857-017 Position 12).
