Condition

Customer states:

- Playback mutes after engine start if reverse gear is selected right away.
- This happens with FM radio. No Audio is available until the customer adjusts the volume manually.

Workshop findings:

 The concern can occur on vehicles produced from week 45/15 or with an MMI update as part of the service campaign 91O2.

Software bug in the MMI.

Production Solution

New MMI software after calendar week 22/16.
