INTERIOR CHEMICAL DISINFECTANT GUIDELINES

Description: This bulletin describes the general guidelines to disinfect and protect vehicle interior surfaces using certain safe chemical products.



Applicable Vehicles: All

- Isopropyl alcohol is advised to use for disinfecting vehicle interior surfaces from viruses and/or bacteria (including but not limited to: COVID-19 & influenza virus).
 - According to the CDC, at least 70% alcohol solutions should be used to disinfect contaminated surfaces.
 - Interior upholstery, leather, and plastic substrates can also be disinfected using isopropyl alcohol.
- Isopropyl alcohol products tend to quickly dry organic matter – which may result in leather surfaces looking dry or faded.
 - Leather conditioner products are recommended to replenish the surface structure and maintain proper finish after disinfecting with isopropyl alcohol.
 - Some examples of leather conditioner products include:

- Hydrogen peroxide, bleach, and ammonia based cleaners are NOT advised due to their strong toxic chemical structure and exothermic properties.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for other cleaning products that use different chemicals than advised in this bulletin.
