#### Introduction

Some 2019 model year RAV4 Hybrid vehicles may exhibit a flutter/rattle noise during vehicle operation from the HV battery cooling fan. A new HV battery intake duct has been developed. Follow the Repair Procedure in this bulletin to address this condition.

# Flutter/Rattle Noise From HV Battery Cooling Fan

### **Repair Procedure**

**TOYOTA** 

- 1. Using Techstream, active-test the hybrid battery cooling fan. Refer to TIS, applicable model and model year Repair Manual:
  - 2019 RAV4 HV: Engine/Hybrid System – Hybrid/Battery Control System – "Hybrid / Battery Control: Hybrid Control System (for AWD): Data List / Active Test"

Is the hybrid battery cooling fan the source of the flutter/rattle noise?

- YES Continue to step 2.
- NO This bulletin does NOT apply. Continue diagnosis using the applicable Repair Manual.
- 2. Replace the HV battery intake duct with the NEW part. Refer to TIS, applicable model and model year Repair Manual:
  - 2019 RAV4 HV: Engine/Hybrid System – Hybrid/Battery Control System – "Hybrid / Battery Control: Battery Blower: Removal / Installation"
- 3. Confirm the flutter/rattle noise is no longer present.
