#### **Condition**

#### **Customer states:**

• They are unable to turn off interior monitoring when following procedure listed in owner's manual.



#### Note:

Interior monitoring can be deactivated by:

- Send two locking requests to the vehicle within 2 seconds.
- Locking request can come from the key remote control, exterior door handle sensor or door lock cylinder.

## **Technical Background**

Error in the interior monitoring systems software parameter.

#### **Production Solution**

New Target Data Container (ZDC) update in the electronic central electrical (BCM) control module, J519 (address word 0009) addressed the condition.
