

Certain Noises After Shutting Off Engine Are Normal

After shutting off the engine, you may hear certain noises coming from the vehicle. Here's the lowdown:

- **Noise from Under Vehicle:** This noise is caused by the vacuum pump inside the fuel evaporation leakage check module (ELCM). Depending on conditions, the pump will come on for about **15 minutes** about **5 to 10 hours** after engine shutoff.
- **Clicking from Under Hood:** This noise is caused by the electric brake booster (EBB) system. The system will come on for about **3 minutes** every time a front door is opened.

Keep in mind both of these noises are just normal vehicle operation and don't indicate a vehicle problem.
