Cause	The noise may be originating from the front lower control arm front bushing.

Correction:

Advised to follow Noise Diagnosis - Front Suspension in service information. If the noise cannot be pin pointed and after a thorough visual inspection of all front suspension parts and chassis ears have not identified the origination of the noise. Replace the front lower control arm front bushing on the side that is making the noise. Follow all the service procedure in SI as written. The torque sequence of the bushing is critical to resolving the issue.
