If an abnormal ping sound from the silencer occurs when cooling down. (Listen in attachment after 8 seconds and 35 seconds)

Follow action under "service"

### **SERVICE:**

Certain model year/vehicle types have an updated muffler in production that may quiet the noise to an acceptable level. The latest supersession should be used in VIDA. A VOR (Vehicle Off Road) may be required to receive the improved version part. A customer vehicle should be released until parts are available at dealer to be installed.
