Supersession Statement

This PI was superseded to update Model Years. Please discard PIT5499A.

The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

Condition / Concern

The customer may state the ABS / ESC MIL is on , the Low Brake Fluid lamp on (master cylinder fluid level is full) or a Service Trailer Brake message. The technician may find codes C0035, C0040, C0045, C0050, C0055, C0267, U0121, U0415 or U0420.

Recommendations / Instructions

Inspect the EBCM connector for water intrusion or terminal corrosion. If either is found, replace the EBCM and replace the effected terminals. Remove the tape from the conduit leading to G400 between the main harness and the ground lug.



If no water intrusion or corrosion is found in the connector, remove the tape from the G400 conduit and continue with published diagnostics. Please note in the repair information if there was water in the conduit.
