Dear Dealers,

Due to ongoing checks of field service and repairs, we have identified a pattern of improper reinstallation of drain hoses during the reassembly of the lower fairings after routine service procedures. To ensure proper reinstallation, we have introduced the application of a button tie to fasten the Airbox drain hose to the fuel-coolant tank breather hose in the lower area of the left fairing.

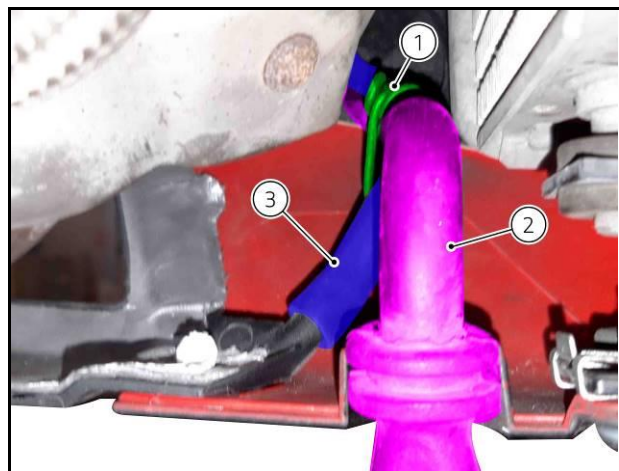
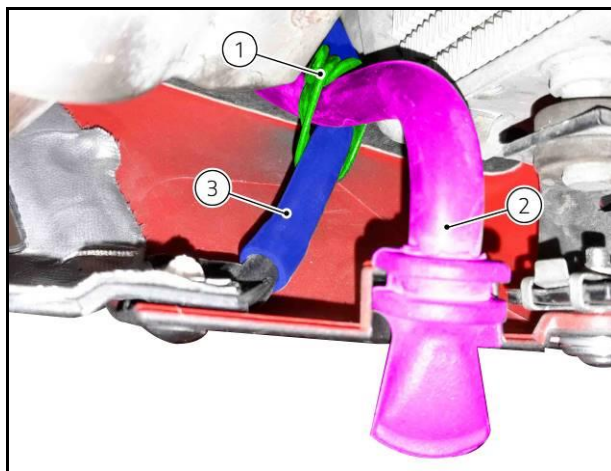
This additional tie is to avoid incorrect positioning of the hoses during the reassembly of the left side fairing. For example, after a service or repair operation and during the reassembly of the fairing, these hoses could have been positioned incorrectly which could possibly interfere with the heat guard of the exhaust manifold.

For all motorcycles manufactured from May 2020 onwards, we have introduced a L=39mm **button tie (1)**, part no.74110551A, to fasten the Airbox drain **hose (2)** to the fuel-coolant tank breather **hose (3)**, as shown in the figure.



NOTE

During the scheduled maintenance operations or upon the first workshop service, for all Panigale V4 models, please check the position of the breather hoses in the side fairing lower connection area and install the L=39mm button tie if it is not present.





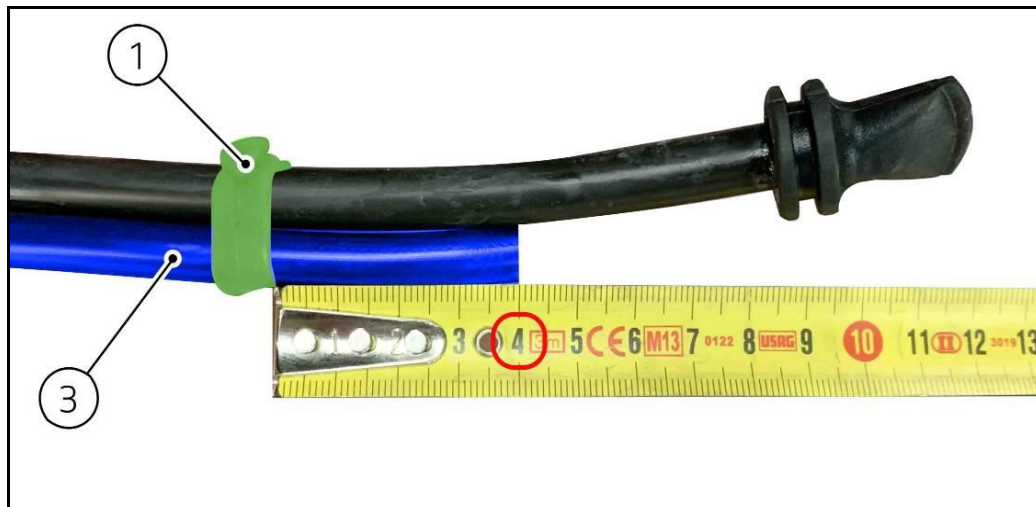
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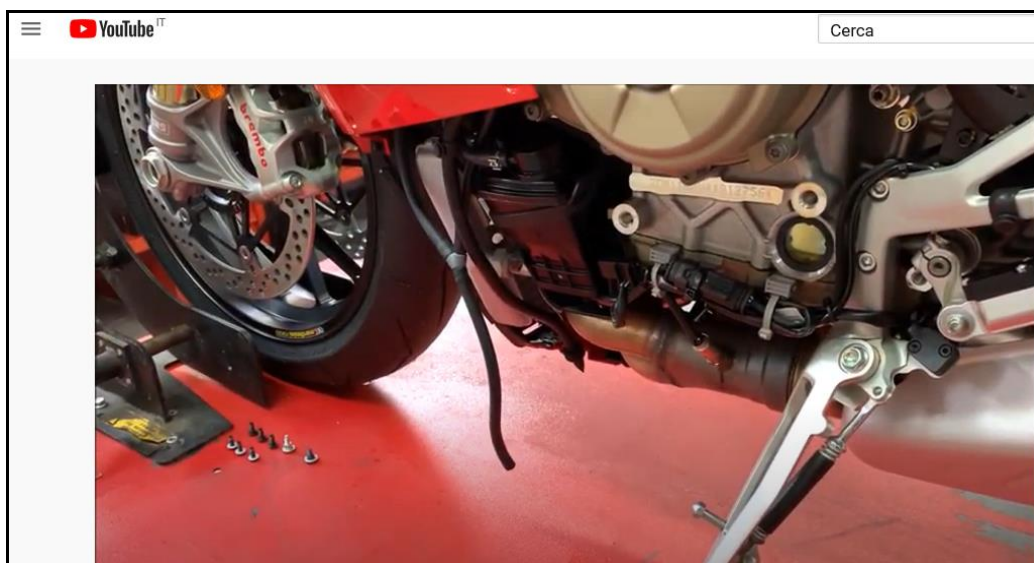


NOTE

The L=39mm **button tie (1)** is positioned at a distance of 4 cm measured from the lower end of the fuel-coolant tank breather **hose (3)**, as shown in the figure.

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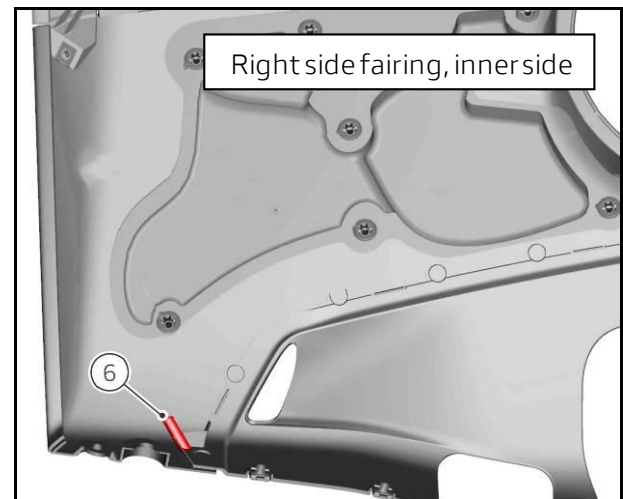
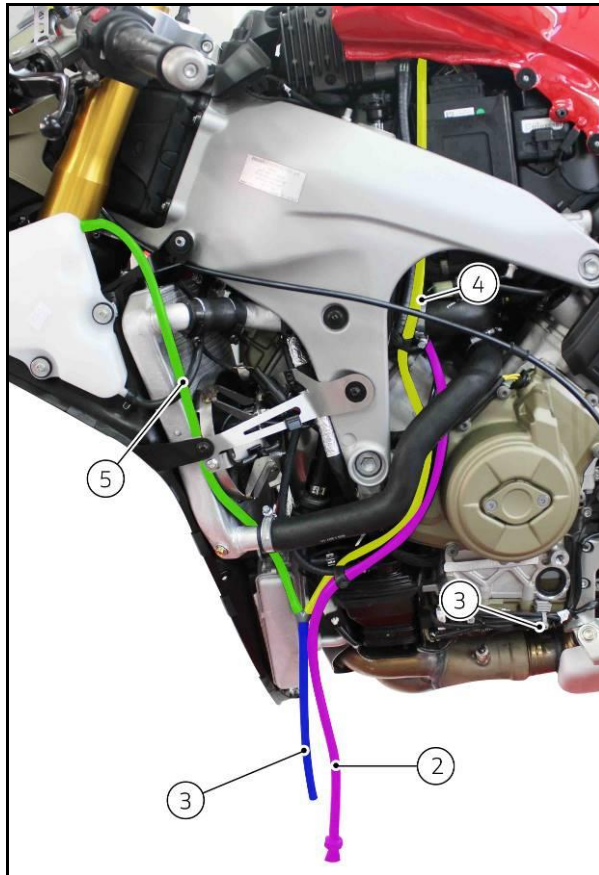
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NOTE

Upon assembly, ensure the proper routing of the following is maintained along the left side of the motorcycle and that **union (6)** inside the lower right fairing silencer cover remains free, as shown in the figure:

- airbox drain **hose (2)**
- fuel tank breather **hose (4)**
- coolant breather **hose (5)**
- fuel-coolant tank breather **hose (3)**



During the scheduled maintenance operations or upon the first workshop service, please check the position of the breather hoses in the side fairing lower connection area and to install the L=39mm button tie if it is not present.



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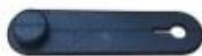


NOTE

When fitting the Ducati Performance by Akrapovič complete exhaust system Part no.96481384C or later, it is necessary to comply with the hose layout shown in this document.

Warranty reimbursement rules

For vehicles where this tie is not present, reimbursement for the L=39mm **button tie (1)**, part no.74110551A can be submitted as a part only NORM type warranty claim.
