DESCRIPTION

When the Telematics Control Unit (TCU) replacement is necessary due to a failure, use MDARS to initialize the new TCU after replacement.

Use the information in this service alert to initialize the new TCU until the procedure on MGSS is updated. **CAUTION:** If TCU initialization is not performed, connected vehicle functions will not operate. This will have a negative impact on the customer because they will need to return to the dealer for repairs. **TCU Initialization**

1. Install a new TCU.

- Mazda3 TELEMATICS COMMUNICATION UNIT REMOVAL/INSTALLATION
- CX-30 TELEMATICS COMMUNICATION UNIT REMOVAL/INSTALLATION
- 2. Turn the ignition ON (engine ON or OFF).
- 3. Connect MDARS to the vehicle.
