Blower motor inoperative due to a blown fuse 5E	2017- Onwards Range Rover , Range Rover Sport and Discovery
<p><b>Customer Voice:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>No airflow from the HVAC system.</li></ul> <p><b>Technical Description:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Fuse 5E 41A in the EJB is found blown.</li></ul> <p><b>Status:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>This is currently under investigation.</li><li>Before any parts are replaced, please take pictures from different angles of the fuse in the EJB.</li><li>If the fuse is found blown, replace the fuse and check the current draw of the blower motor.</li><li>Verify the manner in which the HVAC is normally operated.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>HVAC is operated in manual or auto mode?</li><li>What is the temperature setting normally used?</li><li>Is the vehicle driven with A/C on and the windows open?</li></ul></li><li>Submit an EPQR with the pictures, customer usage and contact details for the parts return of the fuse and blower motor.</li></ul>
