#### TAILGATE DOES NOT OPEN COMPLETELY

# **SITUATION**

When opened either from the remote key, activation button on the driver's door panel, or using foot motion via Comfort Access; the tailgate will not open completely. The tailgate will release, open a small amount, and stop as shown below:



## **CAUSE**

A software error in the automatic tailgate control unit (HKFM).

#### CORRECTION

Program the vehicle using ISTA 4.23.1x (I -level S18A-20-03-558) or higher.

## **PROCEDURE**

Determine the vehicle's current I-level by either using AIR or the Key reader/ISPA NEXT application.

For vehicles below the I-levels outlined:

Program the vehicle using ISTA 4.23.1x or higher (released May 2020).

Model	Target Integration level
G06 (X6 Sports Activity Coupe)	<b>S15A-20-03-558</b> or higher

Note that ISTA will automatically reprogram and code all programmable control modules that do not have the latest software.

Always connect a BMW-approved battery charger/power supply (SI B04 23 10) when performing programming.

For information on programming and coding with ISTA, refer to DealerSpeed / TIS / Technical Documentation / Diagnostics and Programming / Programming Documentation.

### PARTS INFORMATION

Parts are not required.

#### WARRANTY INFORMATION

During this workshop visit, the affected vehicle may also show one or more programming and encoding Technical Campaign repairs open, the programming and encoding procedure may only be invoiced one time.

Update the vehicle to the required i-level or higher by performing and submitting for one of the open Technical Campaigns instead. Please be sure to also perform any additional work (before and/or after) the campaign repairs require and/or close the remaining open programming and encoding Technical Campaign repairs as outlined in the corresponding Service Information Bulletin.

Only if the above situation does not apply, the BMW software solution is then:

Covered under the terms of the BMW New Vehicle Limited Warranty for Passenger Cars and Light Trucks or the BMW Certified Pre-Owned Program as described below.

#### Programming and Encoding - Vehicle Control Units (RO and Claim Comments Required)

The programming procedure automatically reprograms and encodes all vehicle control modules which do not have the latest software I-level. If one or more control module failures occur during this programming procedure:

 Please claim this consequential control module-related repair work (including performing the IRAP Control Unit Recovery procedure first as required, refer to the SIB in AIR) under the defect code listed in this bulletin with the applicable AIR labor operations.

Explain this additional work (The why and what) on the repair order and in the claim comments section

For control module failures that occurred prior to performing this programming procedure:

When covered under an applicable limited warranty, claim the applicable test plan and the
corresponding control module-related repair work using the applicable defect code and labor
operations in AIR (including diagnosis with separate punch times).
