VIBRATION WHEN DRIVING AT 1500-1650 RPM

DESCRIPTION

Some customers may complain about a very low frequency noise and/or vibration felt at the steering wheel, the floor and/or the seats when driving at 1500-1650 rpm in any gear position. This may be caused by normal vehicle behavior while the cylinder deactivation is active (two cylinders drive). The state of the cylinder deactivation can be monitored in the center display to help verify if this is the issue.

WARNING: DO NOT keep your eyes focused solely on the display while test driving. For your safety, keep your eyes on the road ahead.

To correct this concern, the radiator mount brackets and the control software of the PCM have been modified to reduce the resonance of the radiator.

NOTE: The combination of the modified radiator mount brackets and older PCM calibration may result in worse vibration.

Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

1. Verify customer concern. The state of the cylinder deactivation can be monitored in the center display to help verify if this is the issue.

WARNING: DO NOT keep your eyes focused solely on the display while test driving. For your safety, keep your eyes on the road ahead.

2. Replace the radiator mount brackets with modified ones.

Bolt tightening torque: 71-88 in-lb (82-101 kgf-cm, 8-10 Nm)

- 3. Verify the VIN of the vehicle.
 - If the vehicle is within the VIN range below, go to step 4.
 - If the vehicle is outside the VIN range, go to step 8 as PCM reprogramming is not necessary.

NOTE: 2020 CX-30 does not need to be reprogrammed.

4. Reprogram the PCM using the Mazda Diagnostic And Repair Software (MDARS). Refer to "MDARS - ECU Reprogramming Procedure". **NOTE:**

- If the current calibration file name on the ECU FILENAME screen is the same as shown in Calibration Information or with a later suffix, reprogramming is not necessary.
- After reprogramming, pending DTC P2610:00 [PCM] will be stored without the Check Engine Light ON. Start the engine and clear the DTC.
- After reprogramming, if DTC U2120:00 and/or U2500:82 are stored and the i-ACTIVSENSE warning light (amber) turns ON, refer to SA-043/20.
- 5. Clear the DTC, turn the ignition off, and get out of the vehicle.
- 6. Close and lock the door.
- 7. Wait for at least ten minutes.

8. Verify the repair by starting the engine and making sure that all warning lights are off. **NOTE:** If any DTC should remain after performing a DTC erase, diagnose the DTC according to the instructions on MGSS.

MDARS ECU Reprogramming Procedure

NOTE: This procedure explains a generic reprogramming for all Electrical Control Units (ECU) such as PCM, BCM, ESU, etc. Be aware that some sentences and screen shots below mention a certain control unit such as "PCM" or "BCM" as an example.

ATTENTION: READ ALL CAUTIONS AND NOTES BEFORE AND AFTER REPROGRAMMING!

CAUTION:

- A poor connection between the vehicle and M-MDS and/or low voltage may result in abnormal termination and/or data corruption. A low battery voltage may cause a reprogramming failure resulting in unexpected ECU replacement.
- Make sure that the following connections are firmly connected, then DO NOT touch the VCM and DLC cable to prevent noise and a poor connection.
 - Between the vehicle-side connector and the DLC cable
 - Between the PC-side connector and the USB port of the PC

• When reprogramming with MDARS, power consumption and voltage fluctuation are greater than with IDS. Connect the GR8 battery charger and use Manual Mode set to 14.5 volts and continuous charging to the vehicle to minimize any voltage fluctuation. DO NOT use any other charger.



BEFORE REPROGRAMMING

NOTE:

- Turn off all electrical loads (i.e. A/C blower, audio system, rear defogger and headlights).
- Perform a self-test and verify no DTCs are stored. If any DTCs are stored, repair the concern and delete the DTCs.
- Disconnect any aftermarket accessories (non-genuine Mazda accessories).
- Terminate all programs other than MDARS on the PC. Running other programs may interfere with the MDARS performance, resulting in the PC freezing or other problems.
- Perform reprogramming with a proper internet connection. When using a wireless network, make sure the connection is strong.
- Make sure to keep enough free space on the PC's hard disc. Insufficient free space (less than 1 GB) may result in the PC freezing during reprogramming.
- If MDARS requires Manual PCM Software Number Entry, follow these steps.
